Description

`liststruct()` lists x 's contents, where x is an instance of structure *whatever*.

Syntax

```
void liststruct(struct whatever matrix x)
```

`liststruct()` is often useful in debugging.

The dimension and type of all elements are listed, and the values of scalars are also shown.

Conformability

```
liststruct(x):  
    x:         r × c  
result:      void
```
