Description

`novarabbrev` temporarily turns off variable abbreviation if it is on. `varabbrev` temporarily turns on variable abbreviation if it is off. Also see [set varabbrev](#) in [\[R\] set](#).

Syntax

```
novarabbrev stata_command
```

```
varabbrev stata_command
```

Typical usage is

```
novarabbrev {
    ...
}
```

program ...
... /* parse input */ ...
novarabbrev {
    ... /* perform task */ ...
}
...
end
```
